VARIETY:	"El Capitan" Syrah
VINTAGE:	2018
APPELLATION:	Texas (Dell Valley Vineyard)
ALCOHOL:	15%
OAKING:	Aged in used French puncheon barrels for 8 months



After a 4 year hiatus, we're excited to release a Texas Syrah to our patient wine club members. Named after the limestone rock face (dubbed "the captain" by Spanish conquistadors) that overlooks the Dell Valley Vineyard in far West Texas.

Ripe, jammy red fruited aromatics with a background of savory, grilled meat notes. Big, rich, and ripe on the palate with luscious fruit and flavors.

Expect this to pair well with grilled pork loin with an apricot glaze, brisket, bbq ribs, duck confit, and rich soft cheeses.
